Graduation Sunday:

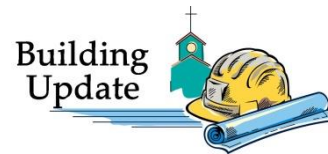

I have a long-term client & friend whose daughter is in a fight for her life. Olivia (don't know her married name) has some form of severe pulmonary hypertension (she's about 30 or 32). She's never smoked, used drugs, etc. They don't know why. Several months ago she went to Vanderbilt & had to have an injector pump to wear with 24 hour a day iv injection to try to stabilize her dangerous blood pressure. She has 2 young kids & tries to work full time. Anyway, this worked for several months but was failing. Last Wednesday they performed a 10 hour surgery to create a shunt to lower blood pressure to give her time until they could do a full lung transplant. The surgery was fine & everyone was happy. Suddenly Sunday things went bad & they tried to correct things thru the leg artery. That didn't work, now they're talking emergency surgery today. No one knows what's going on but the doctors are very frustrated & very negative right now. So some prayers are in order if possible
