Second Collection for Response to Hurricane Florence and other Disasters

On November 4, the Diocese of Knoxville will take up a second collection for Hurricane Florence Disaster Relief as part of a nationwide effort to assist victims. Funds will be used in response to Hurricane Florence and any other natural disasters that occur this year. Funds will assist the ongoing efforts of Catholic Charities USA to provide humanitarian aid for the immediate help of those in need in the affected areas, as well as to the long-term efforts to restore communities after such widespread destruction. Also, funds will go to support the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops' efforts to assist with pastoral and reconstruction aid to the Church. Humanitarian funds for any future disasters impacting communities outside the US may be shared with Catholic Relief Services for their response efforts.
